Comments: I strongly oppose the Wilderness designation for the Heart Lake Loop & Stateline Trail without a non-motorized travel corridor for the trails. I otherwise support the action to achieve large landscape conservation goals via the Great Burn Recommended Wilderness. I request that the Nez Perce-Clearwater and Lolo NF align their management policies. The biking community does a great job of clearing trails and maintaining trails and have minimal impact or erosion of the trail systems and a non-motorized travel corridor will keep a fantastic bike trail accessible.

I support the recommendations for the Lolo Creek Geographic Area. There is no need to further restrict this bike access in this area and this is one of my favorite biking locations.

I am a huge advocate and support the recommendation for backcountry designation in the Cube Iron Roadless Complex. This will maintain primitive characteristics while allowing for bike access, which are important to me.
