The only road maintenance on RS99 should be for potholes and only two before Franklin bridge. After that no maintenance should occur. RS99 should not be expanded or modified in any way.

No e-bikes. This is to preserve the notion that the RNRA was in part established to provide opportunities for exploration, challenge, self-reliance in a naturally appearing landscape.

Once Mountain Water removes its dams, there should be no new implements, no new intakes in the RNRA. Once they remove the dams, they shouldn't be permitted to build any new structures of any type, nor should they have motorized access to RS99 once the dam removing process is complete.
