Comments: Dear USFS, I have many forms of recreation in the outdoors including hunting, fishing, hiking, climbing, skiing, and mountain biking. I appreciate and cherish the idea of multiuse access. Please consider the following points for the Lolo NF plan:

*Heart Lake Loop, near Superior. Due to permanent loss of access, I strongly oppose these trails being recommended for a Wilderness designation unless a non-motorized travel corridor is established as was recently recommended for the adjacent Stateline Trail managed by the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forest. *Carlton Ridge to Mill Creek, on Lolo Peak. I support the recommendations for the Lolo Creek Geographic Area as these trails will remain open to bikes.

*Cube Iron Roadless Area, near Thompson Falls. I strongly support the recommendation for a Backcountry management designation in this area which will maintain primitive characteristics while allowing for bike access.
