I believe using fire in a prescribed burn in the Sandia Mountains is a bad idea because historically, prescribed burns do not do well in New Mexico for three reasons: 1) low humidity; 2) high winds; 3) winds that change direction. Just last year there was a very large burn scar in New Mexico caused by a prescribed burn that harmed a lot of people.
