Comments: 2.2.2 Sustainable Recreation and Scenery

GENERAL: Provide freedom of choice for the broadest spectrum of outdoor recreation opportunities compatible with the setting.

Desired Conditions (FW-REC-DC

- 12. Glad to see recognition of "minimal impacts." Please recognize the humans are part of our ecosystem and give tolerance compatible with other resource values.
- 13. Remember that replacing of eliminating dispersed recreation merely moves, not eliminates, the dispersed impacts to another place and results in dissatisfied users.

Objectives (FW-REC-OBJ)

01 Favor rehabilitation or site hardening over removal or relocation.

03 Include loops for motorized use. Motorized loops are essential to minimize ORV impacts. Examples are available where loops almost negated ORV localized impacts in meadows, hill climbs etc.

Guidelines (FW-REC-GDL)

03 Utilize fuel breaks, temporary roads, skid trails to accommodate foot traffic (walking, hunting, etc.) whenever cost-effective and campatible with adjacent area.

07 Loops are necessary to minimize ORV impacts. Inevitably dead end routes experience resource damage along or at the end of the route.

01 Decommisioned or stored roads should be in a condition to allow foot traffic for walking, hunting and other non-commodity uses.
