I am excited for the Gold creek restoration project, however I am concerned about impact on my hobby for duration of the project. Free-flying community, and me included usually launching paraglider (soft canopy made of cloth) from Rampart, and landing on the road by the i-90. It is one of the most beautiful and accessible Apline flying sites in PNW!

Typical day usually involves hiking up to Rampart on the FSR, setting up and launching about 12pm, and landing by the foothills.

Could you please make schedule of helicopter use during restoration available publically, so freeflyers could deconflict and avoid flying in the same time. Community already relies on the similar deconfliction methods by checking airbase training flights, before embarking on the hike.

Alternatively use post TFR via FAA when helicopters are in use.
