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Comments: The proposed list of improvements far exceeds the carrying capacity of such a fragile environment and should be wildly scaled back. Not to mention the existing access road that travels through both Eagle and Garfield County that will probably not be improved to handle the level of traffic generated by this State Park as proposed.

Please do not change the character of Sweetwater Lake as is proposed, you will ruin everything good about it and turn it into a "destination" for Front Range and Out of State visitors like what was done to Sylvan Lake, which was once a nice place to visit or spend a day fishing or hiking in relative solitude or with a few local families.

Not everything has to be bastardized by Governor Polis and the State CPW department for a new income stream or as a destination. This project should be denied for numerous impacts to the Lake and immediate area.

Keep Sweetwater Lake as it is today, maybe improve 10 primitive campsites and an equal amount of limited parking and improve the area very slightly - do not make it a destination resort at the expense of the quality environment like as shown on the NOI project map.

Employee housing ?? Eight to Twelve cabins and over 20 campsites assure its destruction and ruin the very thing that was claimed to be protected through the campaign. This plan is a disgrace and should be torn up and thrown in the trash.
