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Comments: Broad exceptions for the cutting of large trees between 21" and 25" that have no sound ecological rationale. Large trees are already deficient on this landscape and are essential for creating a complex, resilient forest. The spotted owl and other species dependent on old growth and multi-dimensional forests will be adversely affected by these decisions.
