Comments: As a resident of Kentucky for over 40 years, my family and I have hiked and camped in various hills and parks in Kentucky for many years. I object to the Jellico Vegetation Management Project EA #63037. I love living in Kentucky but I strenuously object to the logging project that has been proposed. Although my preference would be to refrain from any significant logging project, at the very least I would not want any forest disruption more than the Alternative 1: 3,000 acres of logging over 4-6 years, including:

? 1,122 acres of two-age shelterwood

? 1,811 acres of commercial thinning

The above alternative is not ideal, but if the 931 acres of clearcut can only be avoided by a smaller, shorter plan I would grudgingly accept that.
