The gate should be moved to the mine property to allow for the TOV designation, as the gate currently restricts public access to Crater Lake and Fish Lake, of which neither are all private property.

I also support trailhead access to Lookout Mountain and Marble Creek trailheads. I believe the two miles of new motorized TOV in Thunder Mountain are would be an added benefit for the recreational users. Dispersed camping should be increased along Profile Road, Thunder Mountain Road above Stibnite to and including Thunder Mountain for the recreationists.

I also support TOV on Quartz Creek Road #067 for a few reasons. First it is the only access to private property and claims. I believe the prescribed bridge replacement would be a terrible financial decision and would ultimately restrict the future development of that property.

Wilson Mine area has been used for hunting and recreation for close to the last 90 plus years. This area is a premium area used for accessing Unit 25 for hunting . It also provides for recreational use of a road that does not affect any streams.
