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Comments: Transparency is critical to collaboration, cooperation and prosperity. The priority must always be the protection of Air and Waters of the US, human health, as well as, health of all forest inhabitants, all species, endangered, threatened, and prospering, while serving the citizens of the United States of America. Important to this objective is full disclosure of health impacts, environmental risk, and potential gains in economics, infrastructure and social gains in education, museums, etc.

While I embrace the need for certain materials and the Fast41 objective, to do so at the risk of the of the Santa Cruz River water shed seems poorly framed. The mine IS the Head Waters of the Santa Cruz River, flowing south to Mexico and then back to the USA via Nogales, primary water supply, and on through Santa Cruz, Pima and Pinal counties, serving Tucson and Marana.

More study is required, in parallel with operations and most importantly openly distributed in near real time, to the host communities and those on the escape routes at a bare minimum. Give the state on Information Technology available (in use at the site) there is no reason to not broadcast Air/Water/Waste/Traffic/Discharge/Nuisance opacity measurements of the Site's, Roads, Crushers, Concentrators, Emission points for Dust from track out, wind and other forces in opacity and PM 2.5/10 along all roads and fence lines, monitor results of all discharge and recharge points, address monsoonal level flooding? address the damage inflicted by draining the water out of the mountain aka dewatering, recharging through the known contaminated surface of a historically polluted area. Many other concerns documented by the local community groups. Please be careful.
