My first comment deals with a better water management plan for Upper Deep Creek which I believe will support greater surface water flow in the Upper Deep creek corridor . When heavy winter storms provide some measure of Groundwater recharge . Do

we have any historical data, actually recorded for starters? If not

then why not? The ForestService has given Snow Valley a great

amount of Public Trust Water Assets and the Stream which was there for many many years before Snow Valley existed needs

to be given greater care and not a paragraph inserted that I found

in the CRMP document giving away as much water as Snow Valley wants, not what they need.

2)I believe with the water management during summer and fall

month no water extraction should take place. Also weekly water

records should be taken during those low water months just to see if there is some impact on water temperatures and surface

flow rates. The rest of the year monitoring should be reported monthly. As well as the use of the Calendar year to reporting

Water extraction numbers. Having split years on reporting isn't something that has history with the Forest Service except this current 2023-24 year, It doesn't represent a true picture of Water extraction for the SV Resort having no considerations for higher heat summer activities uses.

3)I still have more time for comments and I might ask a few more before the time is up. What I would like to see is my comments recorded so I can read them as well as others. Maybe seeing other issues that still need to be addressed.

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
