We think it would help if the state park were more closely managed in the meantime, aka now. There needs to be multiple bear-proof public trash cans at the day use area and at the plastic boat dock. I saw people leaving bags of dog poop at the day use area, for example. There needs to be better signage at the boat dock. There needs to be 1-2 potable, public water spigot. The walk-in put in by the day use area needs to be immediately trimmed back of brush and better equipped than those dangerous planks in the mud where someone could get hurt.
