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Comments: I am deeply concerned about allowing e bikes on trails. OET has worked for the past years with CODA and other bike organizations to establish rapport between equines and cyclists with tremendous success. Adding motorized bikes to our trails presents a huge problem for both hikers and equestrians. How does the FS plan to "police" the use of e bikes? Once they are on the trails the bar will lift and series 2 etc will sneak in not to mention "adaptive" bikes. I have already had what could have been a disastrous experience on the STA with three bikes who wouldn't slow down, passed our horses at high speed close by us. Why do these bikes have to be on trails? Let them ride all the roads out there in the forest They are dangerous to hikers and horses.
