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Comments: I support the removal of invasive species in the Siuslaw National Forest or for all national forests for that matter. There was already an extensive invasive species removal plan in place for the Oregon Dunes National Recreation area but unfortunately the Coastal Marten being listed as threatened disrupted those plans. The European beach grass is invasive and even the pine trees in the deflation plain don't belong there. Therefore those invasive species are not native to that area and should not be considered valid habitat for the coastal marten. The coastal marten have plenty of habitat in the more mature forests that are east of highway 101. I support having the invasive species removed at the dunes in order to restore (as much as possible) the natural dune building process by removing the foredunes.
