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Comments: Allowing for electronic assisted bicycles into NF areas is bad policy. They are disruptive to both the enjoyment of trails by public users and to wildlife.

The quiet nature of them could lead to increased human/wildlife conflict if users were to come across wildlife at high speeds.

Additionally, they provide an assisted advantage for more people to reach deeper and more remote areas that will further disrupt animal migrations and refuge during summer feeding and rearing seasons.

They will encourage individuals to bring more gear and supplies further into public lands, all of which are increasingly likely to be left behind and thus turned into garbage on public lands.

E bikes on public lands is bad policy.
