Comments: The nepa document does not address the concerns of the current cattle permittees. The concerns are, 1. there shall not be any reduction in A.U.M.numbers

2. There shall be no restrictions, or inhibit access to the lake creek deep creek allotment from the southeast portion of the proposed development that are currently being used. This access point is one of only 2 access points and is the only all weather access point for the lake creek deep creek allotment.

3. The proposed boundary includes areas that are within the current cattle allotment and includes the area in the south east corner of development that weren't part of the original land purchase. There is no justification for this additional land. There is a need for cattle containment and loading facilities in that area. along with livestock trailer parking on that side of the lake. With increased use of the area, livestock human conflicts will occur and need to be addressed. This boundary needs to be taken out or justify it's addition

4. There is a need for cattle loading and containment facilities on the south east side of the lake as well as on the west side to access the sweetwater forage reserve as this is only accessible from the lake area.

5. Since there is very limited shoreline access on the southeast side of the lake, only a small number of parking spaces should be at that location, maybe 10 to 12, and add 4 livestock trailer parking spaces for day use as the trails on that side of the lake are generally shorter in length. Under the current proposal, all of the trailer parking is on the north side of the lake which would require riders and livestock to travel the entire distance across the development increasing camper and livestock conflicts.

6. Make sure it is posted that the trails onto the forest permit area are foot and horseback only and no unleashed dogs. Keep all gates closed.
