On many occasions, I have come across the trash left behind by shooters bullets, broken bottles, aluminum cans, bullet casings, paper targets and miscellaneous trash. Additionally, I have found trees with bullet holes in them and in some cases trees that were fatally damaged. Frequently, I have encountered very drunk people shooting dangerously close to hiking trails. There have been several occasions when there were children with us while the drunks shot recklessly as we passed. There have been many occasions when we were hiking on marked trails and we've heard shots fired nearby, later encountering folks who'd decided to set up a shooting range and shoot into the area we were hiking in.
