Comments: The Forest Service's primary duty is to protect the wild nature of the Mount Timpanogos Wilderness, not maintain structures like the Quonset hut, which degrades the area and isn't needed for managing the Wilderness. Their policy states visitors should be prepared for risks like bad weather, isolation, and lack of quick communication without relying on structures. The plan to use helicopters and build a new structure contradicts the Wilderness Act, which prohibits such developments. The Forest Service should consider alternatives that preserve the wilderness, such as allowing the hut to naturally deteriorate or using non-motorized tools for its removal.
