I am writing to express my strong support for the federal purchase of the 80,000 acres of state school trust lands within the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness (BWCAW), along with the additional 3,200 acres of land in St. Louis County that is included in this purchase proposal.

A federal purchase would significantly enhance the management and protection of the BWCAW as a designated Wilderness area. By securing these lands under federal oversight, the likelihood of future development by state or county governments is eliminated, ensuring the enduring preservation of this national treasure. Additionally, this step would streamline the administration of the BWCAW, allowing for greater conservation efficiency.

Congress, through the creation of the Land and Water Conservation Fund, explicitly envisioned such transactions for the purpose of conserving valuable landscapes like the BWCAW.
