Comments: After seeing analysis by the local Timberjay newspapers as well as other sources I have come to the conclusion that a federal purchase of the 80,000 acres of state school trust lands inside BWCAW as well as the 3,200 acres of St. Louis County land would provide far more income to Minnesota's Permanent School Fund than would a land exchange.
