Comments: Routinely, USFS approves plans that entail logging of old-growth forests despite the best evidence that these unique and rare forests harbor a disproportionate share of our biodiversity and are an essential tool for climate change mitigation. The current plan is no different. USFS must commit to a full and complete halt of all logging operations on any virgin land -- any land that has not been previously logged -- rather than quibbling about definitions of 'old growth' and finding loopholes and work-arounds.
