I ask that the Forest Service move ahead with the federal purchase of the school trust lands within the BWCAW, and ignore the plea from the state legislators for a land exchange.

I will repeat points that were suggested by Wilderness Watch since they coincide with my feelings and are more articulate than what I would write.

A federal purchase will increase the efficiency of administering and protecting the BWCAW as a Wilderness, and prevent future state or county governments from developing these lands.

A federal purchase will provide far more income to Minnesota's Permanent School Fund than would a land exchange, according to analyses by the local Timberjay newspaper and others.

Unlike the assertions of the local legislators, a federal purchase is perfectly legal under the Weeks Act. Furthermore, Congress created the Land and Water Conservation Fund for just such purposes.
