Some these burns are taking place in early spring when Song birds Turkeys and other critters are trying raise their young plust the areas they burn are big and alot times fires get so hot they burn down into soil which isn,t good. The forest is always complaining about not having enough money well if they go back to Selling timber on USFS lands they will have monies within their budgets to maintain roads7 recreation areas etc.The forest service seems to have problem when put out a timber sale for bid. One of these enviromental groups will file a lawsuit in Federal court and the USFS will fight the suit in court and not make the timber sale. Diversity in our forest is the key for healthy forest that benefits all of of our wildlife species
