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Comments: I am a member of the four wheeling club called the cliffhangers. The other club members and I have been using the trails on the forest service land for quite some time. Access to the trails is fairly good now and the club in my opinion has been respectful of the lands we travel on.

There could be a couple things that could be implemented to ensure safe access to and on the trails. In other areas I have four wheeled in there are some obstacles we call gate keepers that basically just allow vehicles that would be capable of maneuvering the trail. These can be just big rocks or a path that would be difficult or impossible for less capable vehicle. There could also be trail signs with various information on them regarding trail difficulty and recommended equipment for safe passage of the trail. Maybe there could be a QR code on the trail signs that visitors could scan for current conditions. It would also be nice to have parking close to the trail heads so people trailering vehicles wouldn't have to park on private land.
