Comments: I am happy to hear that you have created an Alternative C, the Wilderness Exclusion Alternative, - now I want to talk about why that should be your preferred choice!

The Wilderness Act has been around since 1964. To comply with the Wilderness Act, the Forest Service should exclude all designated and recommended Wildernesses from its proposed cutting and burning plans for the Sequoia and Sierra National Forests. In addition the Forest Service should also add the Moses Mountain Recommended Wilderness to the areas covered in Alternative C.
