Comments: There must be adequate and enforceable assurances regarding restoration of property whenever any mining operation is undertaken. The structure and strength of the company performing the work must be assured. If the company is not strong, or the owners are not easily available, then security is appropriate only if the security includes enough to deal with every possible damage plus inflation. My concern is that the majority shareholder had to force a sheriffs sale to get into that position and the majority shareholder might not be available to address damage since it is based in Hong Kong. In addition, we need to know where the mining minerals will end up because I am understanding some of them are very necessary for use in the United States.
