Comments: The proposed massive cutting and burning plans for the Sequoia and Sierra National Forests is is nothing short of irresponsible and inconsistent with the 1964 Wilderness Act. I have personally witnessed and experienced the negative effects of human-driven cutting and burning on a much smaller scale by the Forest Service the past few years in Arizona and I cannot imagine the immense negative effects to the beautiful land and animals that will be impacted by this project.
