I have been recreating in the San Bernardino National Forest for over 40 years. During this time, I've seen more and more land closed, consumed, mismanaged, and reappropriated unjustly. I think it is shameful that the final single track trail(s) in the region that are motorcycle accessible is under threat with frivolous plans. The area is already grossly overcrowded due to closures and mismanagement and I myself have experienced head-on collisions in the areas around the pinnacle staging area and two track roads to Deep Creek. I no longer ride motorcycles on to two-track roads for this reason. If this closure takes place, I hope the parties making the decision are held accountable for the increasingly dangerous conditions that will be presented to OHV users. I myself, will no longer have any reason to visit the area and will take my recreation dollars to other forest and states who provide truly shared user experiences. I will go to areas that promote a safe environment with plenty of trails for ALL types of users with controlled directions of loops, and multiple access for all recreations. The San Bernardino mountains like any other area can benefit from trails that parallel or criss-cross a network for different user types. Two-track, narrow UTV trails, mountain biking, motorcycle trails, as well as hiking trails can all be networked with proper management. Closure is not management; closure is a fail to manage.
