Suggestion where grazing is used, The use of goats over other grazing animals. Reasoning for goats is due to they have a small footprint and are less destructive to landscape. (Cattle large footprint and stream destruction.) Sheep woolled carry invasive seeds in there wool.

Goat carry very little seed & seed pass through is little at best, this is due to the nature of there digestive system.

Need additional expansion of definition on Targeted grazing to open grazing as to cover larger landscapes. Target grazing works well on targeted fuel breaks however due to the large burn scar open grazing to control brush is badly needed and needs to take place no less than a few years after the fire. If not you loose your opportunity to keep brush fuels loads low.
