If the normally elusive cat ventured near a busy road, it seems logical to assume that lynx would avail themselves of the more remote habitat in the proposed logging area. Before any logging begins, the Forest Service should conduct a more thorough evaluation of the proposed project's effects on the Canada lynx and other endangered species, including the American marten.
