Comments: I request that you oppose the decision on the "Telephone Gap Integrated Resource Project #60192" Please tell the Green Mountain Forest managers that the logging of approximately 10,000 acres, much of it old-growth forests, is NOT in the best long-range interest of forest ecosystems or human communities.

- > Old growth forests sequester more CO2 than young forests, and so are more valuable standing than cut as we struggle to prevent the escalation of global warming.
- > Forests protect water quality by preventing erosion and even mudslides, and help to temper local climates.
- > Herbicides are not necessary and are ill-advised, as they introduce toxins dangerous to wildlife and likely to contaminate mountain streams.
