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Comments: The reconstruction section of the 22Jan2025 Montlure Camp Rehabilitation Project Public Scoping Letter excludes the rebuilding of the cabins that were destroyed by the 2011 Wallow Fire, stating, "The cabins cannot be rebuilt at this time and will require a licensed engineering inspection and recommendations due to the hydrology/drainage issues around their old locations." Certainly by following the Apache County building safety ordinances which include international building codes which in turn contemplate such things as soils and drainage, the cabins could be rebuilt following standard practices of construction permitting and inspections that would address any concern the USDA Forest Service might have.

Excluding the reconstruction of the three cabins or over 40% of the available camper beds falls too far short of truly rehabilitating Montlure. Replacing the lost cabins must be part of the planning for the Montlure special use permit.
