The way it is now if they get across , the bridge would collapse due to the weight and would be stranded.

Would really like to speak to some to consider a culvert to replace the wooden bridge. It will be very beneficial for the future of the forest.

We maintain our property by keeping our lawn mowed and area around our property cleaned up. I feel prescribed burns are necessary to keep the the floor of the forest clean and new growth but has concern that in some cases prescribed burns get out of control.
