Comments: Immediate action is essential to protect the Flathead River and the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex, ensuring the preservation of its wild character. The Forest Service must strengthen scientific data collection to accurately determine user capacity, addressing wildlife displacement caused by current recreation levels. Flights in and out of Schafer Airstrip in the Great Bear Wilderness must be regulated to mitigate their impact on the Middle Fork of the Flathead. Public use should remain the priority on these wild rivers, with commercial outfitting and guiding limited to only what is "necessary and proper" under the Wilderness Act. Comprehensive data collection must encompass the entire Flathead River corridor, extending a quarter-mile on either side, to inform sustainable management decisions. Additionally, immediate steps are needed to align impacts along the South Fork with the area's Wilderness Management Plan, safeguarding its ecological integrity.
