In fact, I would suggest that it just needs a break from commercial logging, maybe for the next 20 years or more. Remember, with the current Forest Plan, you are required to consider the structural stage objectives. Please provide a map of the structural stages for the project area. Which structural stages will the commercial logging be taking place in, 4B or 4C? How will your planned commercial treatments affect these two structural stages? Frankly, I have a difficult time believing there is any 4C even left in the project area, it has been that impacted. Other parts of your proposed action make sense to me. Please thin the doghair thickets of young pine left behind from the Lyons Project where all the overstory was removed and these dense thickets remain. Please consider dropping the commercial logging from this project. Leave the 4B and 4C stands alone. There is hardly any of that even left out there.
