Comments: It horrifies me to think that we would deliberately burn 84,000 acres of our precious wilderness. These protected lands are home to endangered species and are wonderlands for naturalists, and the common people wanting a wilderness experience. Please consider this option.

The proposed massive manipulation of up to 84,000 acres within the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness (BWCAW) will violate the Wilderness Act's directive to preserve the area's wildness and wilderness character.

The Forest Service should instead allow natural lightning-caused fires to play their role in the BWCAW.

The draft EA totally fails to analyze whether, when, or how the Forest Service will allow natural fires to burn in the BWCAW if the proposed action proceeds.
