Teton Pass is a world-class asset to Jackson Hole because of its easy access, its beauty and the recreational opportunities it offers. Teton Pass is over-used as a natural place by any standard. The Forest Service must take care of the users already there. Skiers, horseback riders, hikers, mountain bikers, and flora and fauna all share this world-class asset and local treasure.
