Comments: My suggested priority inclusions:

1) stream bank set backs for logging need to have a rigorous enforcement mechanism and the setback specifications and sediment mitigation efforts may need to be expanded to keep logging and trail building activities from adversely impacting salmon and other fish habitats.

2) some environmentally safe and sustainable logging should be allowed, especially if it involves native organizations lending their understanding of the forest in the planning and permitting process AND any such plans should involve a commitment to local value added activities to get maximal economic and cultural value from the harvest. In other words, keep out the big, destructive, scraped-earth companies and go for smaller companies working in a coop sort of arrangement with local labor and local mill operators.

3) culturally sensitive trail building, signage, and indigenously led tourism opportunities

4) look for ways to get more involvement of local indigenous people in the guided hunt industry
