With the road circling Trout Lake and ending at the top of Lizard Head Pass (Galloping Goose Trail), there is no need to damage the environment constructing a new trail with the same end points. The existing road is completely adequate - much more than adequate actually. I both walk and drive the road regularly in the summertime and neither hikers (while I'm driving) nor vehicles (while I'm walking) present any issues. Both foot and vehicle traffic are light.

The only issue I encounter is minor dust as vehicles pass me while walking. If there's money to burn, I would much rather see money spent watering or oiling the road versus destroying pristine land. But really, I'd rather nothing be done at all.
