Comments: Greetings USFS! With the recent Change of Federal Administrations I am Gravely concerned for the Future management of our Federal Forest lands. My concerns are as follows:

1. Incorporate WET and RAINFOREST life zones into your planning for each National Forest, but particularly the Siuslaw National Forest
2. The DEIS is outdated and needs to be UPDATED on a regular basis; especially in light of Rapid Climate Change.
3. The DEIS needs serious revision to include Wildfire Refugia Science for wildfire resistant management.
4. Forest Thinning for all Moist, Wet, and Rainforest Forests must retain 70percent canopy cover for wildfire resistance.
5. Commercial thinning must be replaced with conservative Scientific information and studies.

As we witnessed during the Clackamas River fires, "Thinning" was unbalanced in favor of Commercial Interests.

6. LSRs should be 'OFF-LIMITS" for Commercial Harvest. We have little enough Old Growth Forest left! Any policy that includes Harvest of Timber from 80 to 119 years old should be Abandoned as a matter of Good Forest Stewardship¹
7. Most Commercial Private forests are Heavily rotated for Income or Wall Street Investments. this practice should not apply to our Precious National Forests!

I look forward to the day when The USFS can reach a True Balance between Harvest and Preservation of our Forests. I URGE you to Carefully consider my comments and the Future Generations of this Great Country!
