Comments: I work, mountain bike and live in the forests of southwest Oregon. I understand the urgent need of our public land management agencies to address the fate of existing and future forests. Change to the NWFP is essential to achieve this. While more management flexibility, especially in dry, east-side forests, may lead to increased fire resiliency and habitat, I am alarmed at many of the proposed changes in alternative B. Essentially, LSRs and matrix on the west-side would be open to the all-out aggressive logging that provoked the lawsuits for which the NWFP was meant to address.

Additionally, I'm confident the current administration will exploit every loop-hole, exception and vaguely worded passage of an amended NWFP to carry out a strong timber-extraction agenda. The lawsuits will return.
