Comments: Thank you for doing site-specific analysis for the Webster Cliff Trail. Proposing complete trail work without motorized tools and equipment is very important. A good alternative would be to relocate this part of the Webster Cliff to within 1000 foot wide existing trail corridor. The relocation of trails should always be within established trail corridors to protect the wildlife, their environments, and natural areas. If necessary, reduced access to trails is a possibility. Again, any work done to relocate trails must be accomplished with traditional skills and tools -- no mechanized or motorized equipment have access to this area due to potential damages. Any changes made to this delicate area has to be accomplished with the least amount of intrusion to the natural areas and inhabitants.
