Comments: I am commenting on the SHARP project, which is meant to re-naturalize some trails, reconstruct others, and build new trails.

If this is the goal of the project, I am in favor. I think that the Sherwin Meadow trail system is one of the TOML's greatest assets, providing multi-use recreational opportunities in an incredible setting. The work that MLTPA has done to build new trails has really benefitted us as a community.

Yes, there are some trails that are suffering from erosion and poor planning (the connector along the edge of Snowcreek Golf Course is the worst). These can and should be rebuilt above grade with modern trail building techniques to ensure that they last and that they are of higher quality. There are redundant social trails in the back loop by Hidden Lake and Enchanted Forest, and the meadow trails that exit towards the Mammoth Rock Connector are also in need of work. That chicken wire water bar is pretty unsightly. I would love to see some of these trails get fixed, but not removed. We should be adding trails to the area (Sherwin Creek area would be a great place to see more intentional multi-use trails), not subtracting.
