We have had an increase in vagrants coming to the canyon and breaking into cabins.

Outside vendors come with conflicts of interest and more arbitrary decision making and appears to be one more way for Forest Service personnel to do less.

I would ask that you take a close look at what you are proposing here, as with dismantling the road to Robert's , not well thought out and already causing trail damage and directing water / debris towards one of the cabins in the canyon.
