When will there be a mutual respect by the American people to honor the stewards of the land(The Natives) who want to protect what beauty and natural resources of this earth we have left. We have an over consumerism problem not only in America but the whole world. We need to be proactive about the choices we are making. I know it's the land of free to have opportunities to live your dream, but as a collective we need to understand and come together to honor this planet so that we have a planet to leave for the future generations. Gain knowledge from our people, sit down, share a table with them. People fear what they don't know. Communication that is honest and transparent is key but listening with compassion and understanding is what sets many apart. Let's start showing the world we know how to honor and respect this earth, that Americans stand a one nation. We have lost so much as a Native Americans, please do not take more, this world is vast, there are other ways. Taku o ki pi cha sni- There is nothing impossible.
