The Black Hills Clean Water Alliance's research tells us that "the project would involve 18 drill pads. Exploration could contaminate water in the upper Rapid Creek watershed, with some proposed drill pads very close to streams. And there is also the potential for contamination or cross-contamination of underground water sources."

In addition, mining would cause disruption of traditional ceremonial practices for Lakotas.
