This project, along with the others that have already been approved, would only further contaminate these sacred lands and strip the Lakota people of their rights to the land.

It truly sickens me to think that we would continue our abuse of Native peoples. I urge you to assure that the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) is followed precisely and a full environmental impact statement is conducted. Knowing that the NEPA process has been cut down to only 28 days, I also urge you to put a 60-day extension on the "scoping" public comment period, so that everyone has an opportunity to make a comment.
