The UCC descends from the pilgrims, who came to North America seeking religious freedom. This freedom is considered central, even primary, to many Americans. Pe'sla is a sacred place of worship where land-based Lakota ceremony takes place. To seize and threaten its well-being is to violate their religious freedom. The US has not historically done enough to respect the religious freedom of its Indigenous people. We must do better.
