Comments: The Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the proposed expansion of Grand Targhee Resort in Alta, Wyoming has many alternatives in the proposed expansion plan which would dramatically increase the resort's size and operations, with major consequences for wildlife, public lands, and the neighboring community.

Wildlife: The expansion would destroy habitat for grizzlies, lynx, wolverines, bighorn sheep, and nesting raptors.

Wilderness & Recreation: It would bring lifts, noise, and infrastructure to the edge of the Jedediah Smith Wilderness, compromising solitude and human-powered recreation.

Community: The base area buildout would quadruple commercial space and double visitor capacity, straining housing, roads, and emergency services. A 2022 study concluded local Idaho governments would see "only costs" from this development.

Please do not allow Grand Targhee to expand beyond its boundary or build huge resort facilities on public land.
